1. Information

SEO - Page Title and Metadata CSV Importer has been developed to facilitate and accelerate the modifications of titles and metadatas with a CSV file and thus easily improve your SEO.

- Define source urls.
 - Link a title and custom metadatas.
 - Specify one or more store views.
- Import a CSV file from the back office.
 - o Activate / Modify / Export the entries from the back office.
- Test the metadatas before deploying with a test mode.

2. Installation

First installation:

- 1. Extract the files from the package to the Magento 2 root directory (or use composer)
- 2. Run the following command:

bin/magento setup:upgrade

3. Enable the Module in Stores > Configuration > Blackbird Extensions > Metadata Importer > General Configuration > SEO - Page Title and Metadata CSV Importer Enabled → "Yes".


Update installation:

- 1. Use composer
- 2. (Or) manual installation
 - a. delete the folder "Metadatalmporter" in app/code/Blackbird
 - b. extract the files from the package to the Magento 2 root directory.
- 3. Run the following command:

bin/magento setup:upgrade


The configuration of the module is available in the administrator panel: Stores > Configuration > Blackbird Extensions > Metadata Importer:



General Configuration

SEO - Page Title and Metadata CSV Importer Enabled	Enable or Disable all existing metadata entries
List of Ignored Parameters	The list of url request parameters keys that will be ignored in request url when applying metadatas entries.
Enable Metadata Entries Override	Set it to Yes will override previously imported metadata entries. Set it to No in order to import duplicated lines, last imported is the most important.
Default Store View(s) on Metadata Entries Import	Defined the Defaults Store View(s) on CSV metadata import used if the field for Store Ids is missing.
Default Active Property on Metadata Entries Import	Set it to Yes will set Imported Metadata Active on import. This field is used only if "Active" field is missing in the CSV file on import.
Default Test Mode Property on Metadata Entries Import	Set it to Yes will set Test Mode available for Metadata entries on import. This field is used only if "Test Mode" field is missing in the CSV file on import.

Store Ids Import Field Name	The name of the column in the CSV file representing Store View lds to import.
Title Import Field Name	The name of the column in the CSV file representing the page Title to import.
H1 Import Field Name	The name of the column in the CSV file representing the main content Title (h1) to import.
Active Import Field Name	The name of the column in the CSV file representing the active property of the redirection record(s) to import. (Values between 0 and 1)
Test Mode Property Import Field Name	The name of the column in the CSV file representing the test mode property of the redirection record(s) to import. (Values between 0 and 1)



4. Usage


To access the back office of the extension, go to Marketing > Blackbird > CSV Metadata Importer .



Import a file:

Download a template of CSV file

Click on "Generate Template" in the back office of SEO - Page Title and Metadata CSV Importer to generate the template file.



Create the CSV file

Rely on the file template .csv which respects the format of the configuration in Stores > Configuration > Blackbird Extensions > Metadata Importer > CSV Configuration.

The first line represents the name of the columns. The column "source" is mandatory but his name could be modified in the configuration.

Each line represents one url source that is linked to titles or metadatas. The list of available column is :

source (mandatory)	store_ids	active	test_mode	title	h1	Custom Metadata Name

The name of the columns is corresponding to the default values of the field names of columns that are defined in the configuration.

The columns are delimited by the "delimiter" (,), the values are encapsulated by the "enclosure" (") and the store_ids are delimited by the "store_ids delimiter" (/) which gives the following example:


source (mandatory)	The source url that will be used to link metadatas.
store_ids	The store view id(s) on which metadatas will be applied. If id is 0, it means that metadatas will be applied on all store views. The values of stores are delimited by the "store delimiter" in the configuration. Default: /.

active	Define if the metadata entry is active. (1 = active, 2 = inactive).
test_mode	Défine if the test mode is active for the metadata entry. (1 = active, 2 = inactive).
title	The title of the page to be shown.
h1	The title of the main header (h1) to be shown.
Custom Metadata Name	The column Custom Metadata Name is an additional column which defines a metadata to add. You can add as many columns as you need. The metadatas will be displayed in the page like this:
	<pre><meta content="My custom metadata value." name="Custom Metadata Name"/></pre>

In the case where one of the optional fields is not filed out, the imported metadatas entries will take the default value defined in the configuration.

Import the CSV file

To import a file, click on "Select a file", then on "Import Metadata File".



NB: If the field "enable metadata entries override" is enabled, the newly imported entries that have the same source url and the same store view id as the already present entries will be overwritten. If the field "enable metadata override" is disabled, the entries will be duplicated and it is the last imported entry that will be used prioritarily.

Apply the modifications:

To apply the modifications, you have to **clean page cache** in order to regenerate the pages with the new information.

To do that, you have to click on the button "Flush Page Cache To Apply Modifications".

Or run this command:


php bin/magento cache:clean full_page

Enable the Test mode

To enable the **test mode**, click on "Enable Test Mode for Current Session". The test mode will be activated for one hour for the current session.

To disable the test mode click on "Disable Test Mode".

When **Test mode** is enabled, entries that have the field "Test Mode" **active** (= 1) are active **for the user** that has the **Test mode enabled**.
